Marc was originally self-taught, but later was trained as a Certified Clinical Hypnotherapist and is a member of the American Council of Hypnotist Examiners, and the National Guild of Hypnotists.

Marc is the director and co-founder of the International Institute of Hypnosis, located in Las Vegas, which is a training facility for Hypnotherapists and Stage Hypnotists.

As a young man, Marc was a competitive water skier and competed on a national level for almost a decade. He also held 3 major sponsorships which included Body Glove, High Output Sports and Oakley.

Marc's childhood idol has been Wayne Gretzky, who is the greatest to ever play the game of hockey. Marc had always aspired to meet him and the first time they met, Marc performed for Wayne's retirement from the NHL at gala for Wayne in 1999. This has been the highlight of Marc's career and to this day, he cherishes his Wayne Gretzky autographed jersey that Wayne so graciously signed for him at that event.

In 1996, Marc was hit head on by a drunk driver and nearly lost his life. With a broken back, fractured skull and brain fluid leaking from his nose, Marc began the healing process using his new found skills in self-hypnosis. After a rapid recovery, Marc began the process of designing an alcohol awareness program combined with his hypnosis performance for high school students. This program toured North America for 10 years and changed the lives of hundred's of thousands of students.

Marc has helped athletes with hypnosis and mind training to enhance their sports performance. These athletes have included World Strongest Man Competitors, Professional Hockey Players, Martial Artists, Professional Figure Skaters, and many other sports. Two of the athletes that Marc helped train went on to win medals at the Winter Olympics.
